#### CHARGE CONFERENCE

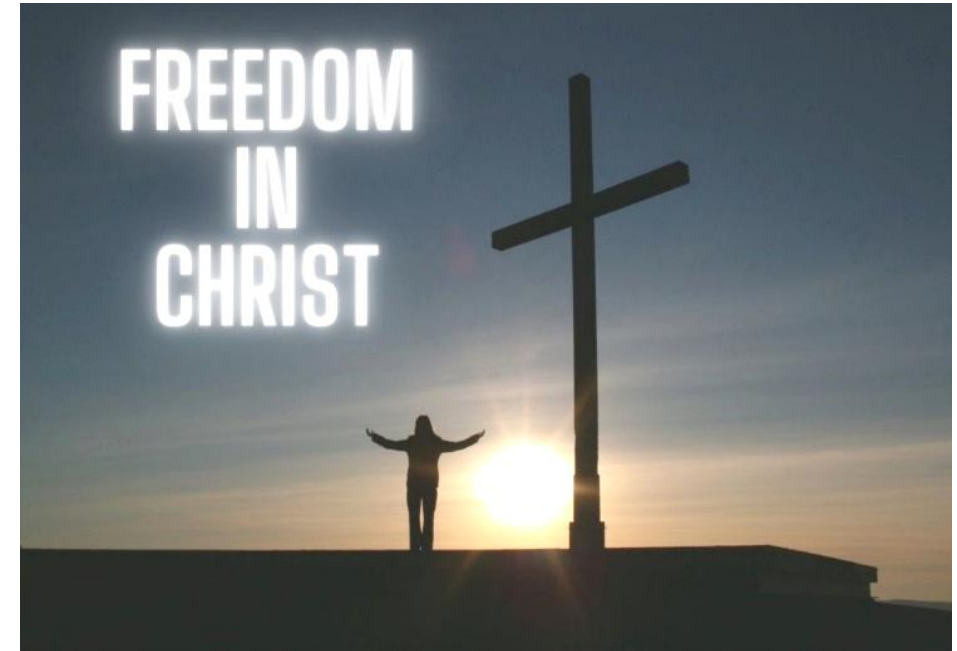
